

**Science Fiction** is an Australian Science Fiction and Fantasy magazine edited by Van Ikin and published since 1977. ♦ During that time it has featured material from various overseas writers - Frank Herbert, Roger Zelazny, Stanislaw Lem, Jack Vance, Gregory Benford - as well as concentrating on the work of Australians from A-Z. ♦♦ (The "A" is Glenda Adams, author of sf novel *Games of The Strong* [1982]; there is no "Z" yet, but we've talked about Alan Yates who wrote sf for the 1950s Aussie pulps.) ♦ In between we've talked with or about most of the major Aussie names in the field, from Broderick and Brown to Williams (Sean) and Williams (Tess) ... with more to come!</p><p><strong>Science Fiction</strong> provides critical reviews of speculative literature, interviews with leading authors and critics in the field, and a range of articles and issues in speculative literature. ♦ The author reference list contains links to many of the listed authors' official web pages and is a wide and varied listing.
